Highlights Algeria's merchandise trade with the G-15 countries is 6% of its global trade. It's biggest trading partner in the G-15 is Brazil.

Algeria has had a steady trade surplus with G-15 countries taken together as well as a global trade surplus.

Individually, Algeria has trade deficits with most G-15 countries except Brazil, Egypt, Iran, Kenya, Nigeria and Senegal.

Algeria's trade with Brazil and Egypt has risen steadily between 2000-2006.

Algeria's trade is miniscule with Chile, Iran, Kenya, Nigeria, Senegal and negligible with Sri Lanka and Jamaica.

In 2006, Algeria's top 5 export destinations were the US, Italy, Spain, France and Canada.

In 2006, Algeria's top 5 import sources were France, Italy, China, Germany and Spain.

Between 2000-2006, Algeria's exports to G-15 countries as a percentage of its global exports declined from 8.2% to 4.8%.

Between 2000-2006, Algeria's imports from G-15 countries as a percentage of its global imports doubled from 4.3% to 8.1%.
