Highlights Around 41% of Argentina's global merchandise trade is with the G-15 countries.

Argentina's biggest trading partner in the G-15 is Brazil

Argentina has trade surpluses with all G-15 countries except Brazil. It also has a trade surplus globally.

Argentina's exports to Indonesia have registered a sharp rise since 2004 while exports to Iran have fallen significantly since 2003.

In 2006, Argentina's top 5 export destinations were Brazil, Chile, the US, China and Spain.

In 2006, Argentina's top 5 import sources were Brazil, the US, China, Germany and Mexico.

Between 2000-2006, Argentina's exports to G-15 countries as a percentage of its global exports declined from 46.1% to 39.8%.

Between 2000-2006, Argentina's imports from G-15 countries as a percentage of its global imports increased from 33.4% to 42.2%.
