Highlights Brazil's merchandise trade with G-15 countries is 24% of its global trade.

It's biggest trading partner in the G-15 is Argentina.

In 2006, Brazil's top 5 export destinations were the US, Argentina, China, the Netherlands and Germany.

In 2006, Brazil's top 5 import sources were the US, Argentina, China, Germany and Nigeria.

Between 2000-2006, Brazil's exports to G-15 countries as a percentage of its global exports increased from 19.9% to 23.4%.

Between 2000-2006, Brazil's imports from G-15 countries as a percentage of its global imports increased slightly from 24% to 24.7%.

Brazil's trade with Algeria, Chile, Peru and Mexico has steadily increased between 2000-2006.

Brazil's imports from Nigeria and exports to Venezuela have risen sharply since 2004.
