Highlights Chile's merchandise trade with G-15 countries is 23 % of its global trade. Its biggest trading partner in the G-15 is Brazil.

Chile has a trade deficit with G-15 countries taken together but a global trade surplus.

Chile's exports to Mexico have risen steadily between 2000-2006. Exports to India, Brazil & Mexico spurred in 2006.

Chile's trade with Egypt has been stagnant since 2000.

In 2006, Chile's top 5 export destinations were the US, Japan, China, the Netherlands and South Korea.

In 2006, Chile's top 5 import sources were the US, Argentina, Brazil, China and Peru.

Between 2000-2006, Chile's exports to G-15 countries as a percentage of its global exports declined slightly from 17.9% to 16.2%.

Between 2000-2006, Chile's imports from G-15 countries as a percentage of its global imports increased from 31.7% to 34.5%.
