Highlights India's merchandise trade with G-15 countries is 9 % of its global trade. Its biggest trading partner in the G-15 is Malaysia.

India has a global trade deficit, and in 2006, a trade deficit with G-15 countries taken together has re-emerged.

India's trade with Indonesia, Malaysia and Sri Lanka has been rising steadily since 2000.

Imports from Malaysia, Chile and Argentina & exports to Mexico surged in 2006.

India's exports to Algeria and Nigeria have increased significantly since 2000 but imports from these economies have stagnated.

In 2006, India's top 5 export destinations were the US, the United Arab Emirates, China, the UK and Singapore.

In 2006, India's top 5 import sources were China, the US, Germany, Singapore and Australia.

Between 2000-2006, India's exports to G-15 countries as a percentage of its global exports increased from 7.8% to 10.5%..

Between 2000-2006, India's imports from G-15 countries as a percentage of its global imports decreased from 9.1% to 8.5%.
