Highlights Kenya's trade with G-15 countries is 11% of its global trade. It's biggest trading partner in the G-15 is India.

Kenya has a trade deficit with G-15 countries taken together as well as a global trade deficit.

Imports from India & Egypt have been rising continuously during 2000-2006.

Exports to Egypt and Nigeria have risen steadily during 2000-2006.

In 2006, Kenya's top 5 export destinations were Uganda, the UK, the US, the Netherlands and Tanzania.

In 2006, Kenya's top 5 import sources were the United Arab Emirates, India, China, Saudi Arabia and the US.

Between 2000-2006, Kenya's exports to G-15 countries as a percentage of its global exports declined from 10.7% to 5.8%.

Between 2000-2006, Kenya's imports from G-15 countries as a percentage of its global imports increased from 9.5% to 13.6%.
