Highlights Malaysia's trade with G-15 countries is 7.3% of its global trade. It's biggest trading partner in the G-15 is Indonesia.

Malaysia has a trade surplus with G-15 countries taken together as well as a global trade surplus.

Malaysia's trade with Indonesia, India, Iran and Mexico has been rising steadily during 2000-2006.

Imports from Argentina and Brazil have risen impressively since 2005.

In 2006, Malaysia's top 5 export destinations were the US, Singapore, Japan, China and Thailand .

In 2006, Malaysia's top 5 import sources were Japan, the US, China, Singapore and Thailand.

Between 2000-2006, Malaysia's exports to G-15 countries as a percentage of its global exports increased from 5.6% to 7.8%.

Between 2000-2006, Malaysia's imports from G-15 countries as a percentage of its global imports increased from 4.5% to 6.7%.
