**Highlights** Mexico's merchandise trade with G-15 countries is 4.8% of its global trade. It's biggest trading partner in the G-15 is Brazil.

Mexico has a trade deficit with G-15 countries taken together as well as a global trade deficit.

Mexico's trade with most G-15 countries, except Senegal and Zimbabwe, has risen steadily during 2000-2006.

In 2006, Mexico's top 5 export destinations were the US, Canada, Spain, Germany and Colombia. The US accounted for 85% of its exports.

In 2006, Mexico's top 5 import sources were the US, China, Japan, South Korea and Germany. 51% of imports were from the US.

Between 2000-2006, Mexico's exports to G-15 countries as a percentage of its global exports doubled from 1.3% to 2.6%.

Between 2000-2006, Mexico's imports from G-15 countries as a percentage of its global imports more than doubled from 3.3% to 7.1%.
