Highlights Zimbabwe's trade with G-15 countries is 1% of its global trade. It's biggest trading partner in the G-15 is India.

Zimbabwe has a trade deficit with G-15 countries taken together as well as a global trade deficit.

Trade with most G-15 countries has remained stagnant during 2000-2006.

In 2006, Zimbabwe's top 5 export destinations were South Africa, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Botswana, the US and Bulgaria.

In 2006, Zimbabwe's top 5 import sources were South Africa, Zambia, the US, Botswana and the UK.

Between 2000-2006, Zimbabwe's exports to G-15 countries as a percentage of its global exports declined from 2.5% to 0.6%..

Between 2000-2006, Zimbabwe's imports from G-15 countries as a percentage of its global imports declined from 3.6% to 1.1%.
